The All Saints Fund is Turning 10

On December 31, 2010 our regional church established a remembering ministry, the All Saints Fund. As the initial investor, Mrs. Lois Drum of our Wheeling First Christian Church, wanted to do something in sacred memory of her beloved husband, Jim. He was a great churchman and believer in long term financial support for Christ's church. It was in many ways, a perfect gift and a perfect start to something new.

The All Saints Fund is open for anyone to remember a cherished saint of the church or honor a living witness among us. The regional board established that for an initial \$25.00 gift a name will be added to the fund. Once a name is established, gifts of any amount may be added.

For the past ten years members of our beloved regional church have provided for names to be honored in a public and formal manner. The account is carefully managed by the Christian Church Foundation. Each quarter the Christian Church in West Virginia receives a distribution of earnings (4.5% annually) while principal is invested for continued long term growth. The monies are unrestricted and support our unified budget.

As of October 1, 2020 the account has grown to \$89,431.99! This is a powerful testimony to the generous nature of Mountaineer Disciples, and it is a robust example to how relatively humble gifts coming together can add up. This life giving fund reminds us daily that the Saints are still speaking.

It seems that we have an opportunity before us as this fund turns 10! Can we, together, reach \$100,000.00 in the fund by the end of 2020? Are there names we should add to our list? Who should we respectfully remember? Who shall we deservedly honor?

Attached is our most recent listing of the Saints. Please pay attention to the names. Look not only to the names of those we remember, but look also to the names of those who have shared. I am touched each and every time I read your names. Thank you.

This ministry is not about money, but it is about people. All those listed are important as we continue to live into the ministry we are called to share.
